Meet Rhea!

Rhea was born in Mumbai and moved to Dubai when she was one year old. She was brought up in Dubai and London and was working with a pharmaceutical company as a senior marketing and sales executive before starting Ecoware.

After a lot of research and study, she self-funded

and founded Ecoware in May 2009, with one factory in Uttarakhand.

In the beginning, Ecoware produced only bowls and plates – the conventional shapes that work well with plastic and Styrofoam. Today, with a team of over 100 people and another factory based in Greater Noida, the company produces more than 16 products.

Rhea's vision is to make Ecoware a household brand synonymous with safe food packaging, and to make it a one-stop shop for all biodegradable packaging products.
