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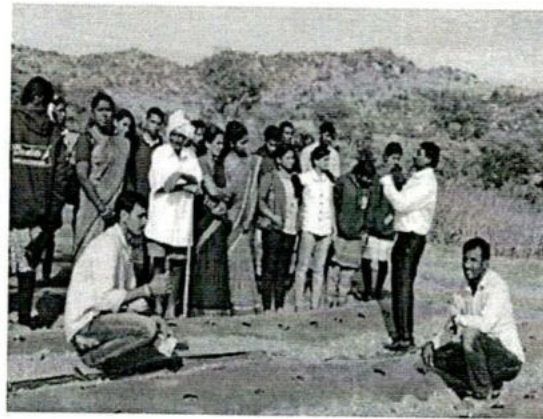
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### REPORT ON VISIT TO APPASWAMY THANDA

On June 20th, 2020, the Department of B.Com collaborated with ESTAH to organize a visit to Appaswamy Thanda in Bagepalli Taluk, Chikkaballapura District, Karnataka. The purpose of the visit was to conduct a multi-crop workshop with farmers, and to provide students with practical knowledge of various agricultural activities. This initiative was undertaken to give the students a taste of rural life and to help them understand the importance of multi-crop cultivation. As many Europeans come to visit and learn about farming activities, it was important for our tourism students to have hands-on experience in this sector. The students found the experience very helpful and expressed interest in having more such experiences. They also organized activities in which the villagers actively participated.



Activity 2: During the year, we had interns from the Netherlands visit our college, and they had a healthy discussion with our students. The interns had the opportunity to learn about Indian culture, our way of living, and our agricultural practices, especially those related to farming. Our students shared their thoughts, ideas, and practices with the interns, resulting in an exchange of knowledge. Through various activities organized by DFFA in association with ESTAR, our students have gained exposure to farming activities in India and how they can be improved for the greater good. They have been taught about backyard gardening, terrace gardening, and other initiatives that can be easily started by students.
