Prof. Mark David Abrams, from Pennsylvania State, USA was the Keynote Speaker and Mr Mark Van de Vrekan, Consul General of Belgium was the Guest of Honour. There were a good number of International Delegates from Italy, Philippines and USA along with many research scholars and professors from various colleges and universities across the country. Nearly 60 research papers on various

9th NCC Annual Day

The 9th NCC Annual Day was organised on February 20, 2020. The Chief Guest of the Day was Col. H R Sunil, Officiating Commanding Officer, 1 KAR BN NCC.

Regularly we were conducting on-line skill development programs for both PG and UG students two days a week, on Mondays and Friday last hour. Sessions like Time Management, Health and Hygiene, etc were conducted as Capacity enhancement and Soft Skills programs. There were a total of 21 sessions conducted for the students. There were also career guidance programs like “Meet your Future” and so on.



Amidst this pandemic 134 students were provided scholarships from the institution and 173 students were supported with scholarships from outside sources. Nine certificate Courses were offered. The process of Course Outcome was attained.

Staff Achievements

Rev. Fr. Jijo Jose, Vice Principal was appointed as BOS for Journalism from the Bangalore University. The number of staff with PhDs has increased and 15 of the staff have enrolled to their PhD degree. The College also organised FDPs for staff like “The Various Influences the Teacher has on a Student” and first online FDP on Quality Enhancement: Online Teaching, Learning and Assessment”.

Online mode of teaching

The College adopted easily adopted to the pandemic situation, converting to Online mode of teaching from third week of March, just a week after the lockdown. The institution signed around 5 MOUs to conduct various activities. Extension activities along with service oriented programs like food distribution and supplying milk to the needed during the pandemic were organised by the institution.

Certificate Courses were offered to students on online mode and all the students benefitted from the courses. Along with the Certificate Courses, Skill Development Courses were also offered for students and many online activities were conducted to keep the students engaged and interactive during the pandemic.

FDPs

The IQAC conducted FDPs for Staff on “The Various Influences a Teacher has on a student” from 1st July 2019 to 05th July 2019. An Online FDP was conducted on “Quality Enhancement: Online Teaching, Learning and Assessment” from 12th May 2020 to 16th May 2020 to orient the faculty on online methods of teaching and evaluation during the pandemic.



Apart from the FDPs conducted by the institution, the faculty participated in various FDPs conducted by other institutions as well. For the non-teaching staff administrative training programs were conducted on Soft Skills for Professional Development on 8th January 2020 and Stress Free Working Environment on 2nd July 2019.

Scholarships and Freeships

Owing to the pandemic all the students were given freeships to support them to cope with the financial crunch during the pandemic. Scholarships were also provided to the needy students.

Eco-friendly measures

Eco-friendly measures were also adopted such as numbering and naming of the plants in the campus to understand the eco-system of the college. Solar power support was proposed and measures were taken to achieve the same. As a ways to empower woman, an award was proposed for women empowerment and the award will be given during the Women's day.

Sports and Cultural activities

Sports and Cultural activities like Vihaan, Prathibha, Razzmataz were conducted for both UG and PG in the odd semester. Many online programs and sessions were organised and a new mode of learning happened during this academic year.
