Report on Career Counselling Session on Civil Services

A Career Counselling session on "How to get prepared for Civil Service Exam" was conducted for the students of PG, B.Com, BBA, BCA, BSc and BA by ALPHA TECH.

The session apprised the students on the importance of Civil Services Examination (CSE). UPSC exams i.e. a nationwide competitive examination CSE is conducted for graduates by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) for recruitment to Civil Services in Government of India including Indian Administrative Service (IAS), Indian Foreign Service (IFS), Indian Police Service (IPS) and Indian Revenue Service (IRS). It is attempted by lakhs of people across the country every year. However, only a tiny fraction of them are able to fulfil their IAS ambitions. The IAS exam is not only challenging in terms of the length of its syllabus, but it is also daunting because of its highly unpredictable nature.

The session shared the information about Indian Civil Service and on how it serves as the backbone of India and carries great respect and responsibilities. India's best brains vie for entry into the Indian Civil Services as officers.

Even though corporate jobs may offer the best of salaries and perks, a majority of youngsters and their parents still crave entry to the prestigious Indian Civil Services held by the UPSC. The very fact that a big share of every year's top posts in the civil services exams are bagged by professionals from various streams, shows that the IAS is still the dream job for many. The session also illuminated on various aspects of how to approach to the examinations. The UPSC exam cannot be cracked by just being a bookworm. The last stage in the UPSC exam

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Process is the personality test round, wherein the UPSC board would interview the candidate for assessing his/her personality and its suitability for a career in the services. This requires an all-round development of the individual apart from academic knowledge. And, even in academics, the focus should not merely be on finishing the syllabus, but on constantly acquiring information and insight into the latest happenings/current affairs within the country and beyond.

The tips to prepare for CSE was discussed among the students. The resource person approached each student and interacted to coin out various shortcuts to approach the exam. The following tips were shared to all:

1. Realise that you have time constraints, so prioritize your time!
2. Buy the most recommended books for CSE preparation
3. Enrol for Clear AS mock test series
4. Utilise your spare time
5. Read newspapers and magazines
6. Keep writing
7. Discuss current issues with your friends
8. Read toppers interviews
9. The NCERT textbooks from classes six to twelve play a very significant role in IAS exam preparation
10. Use Important Government Resources like PIB, PRS, and national television programmes featured on the Rajya Sabha TV

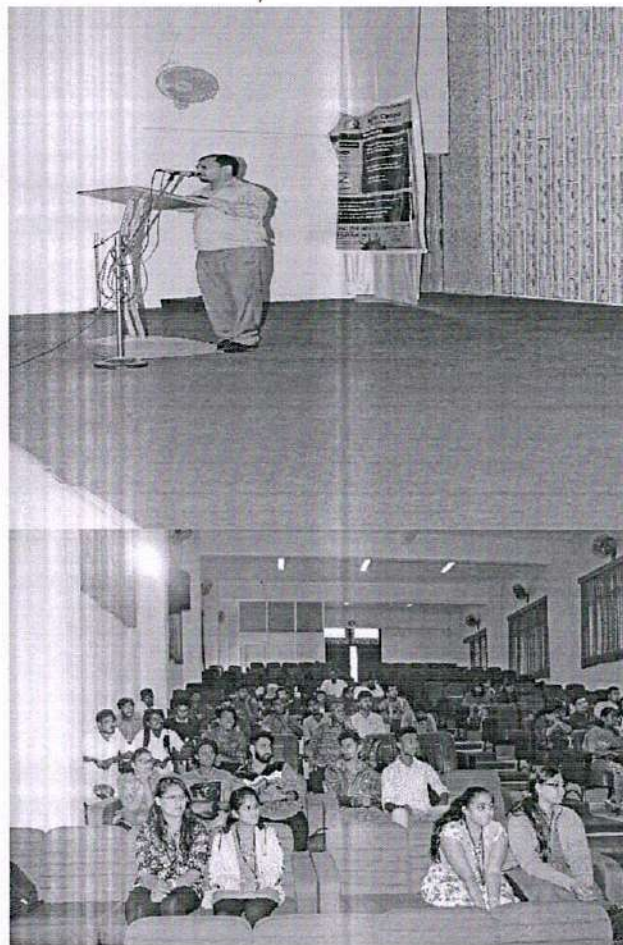

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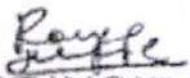
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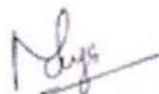
Inaugural function of career counselling session
