The cylindrical graphite pencil, because of its usefulness in easily producing linear gray-black strokes, became the successor of the older, metallic drawing stylus, with which late medieval and Renaissance artists and tradesmen sketched or wrote on paper, parchment, or wood.

Dr. Arpita has taken special lecture on pencil art. She has explained about different types of pencils and its use. Even she has observed students sketch and guide them.

The celebration initiated the enthusiasm among the students about the fine arts skills. It motivated and brought positive perceptions about art among youths.
