- The role of this particular committee is wide and varied and to execute and accomplish the multi oriented tasks the following associations are part of it in jointly administering and achieving the objectives

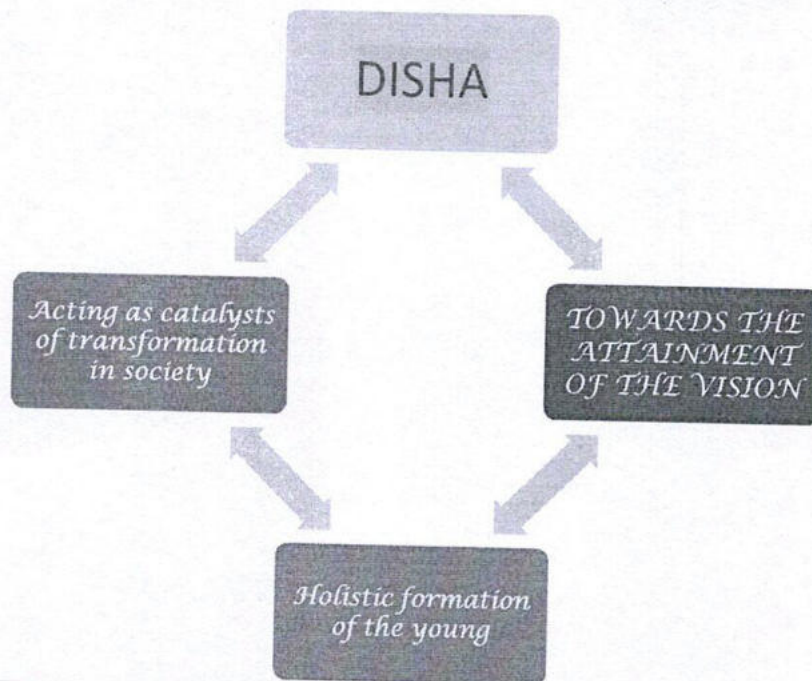
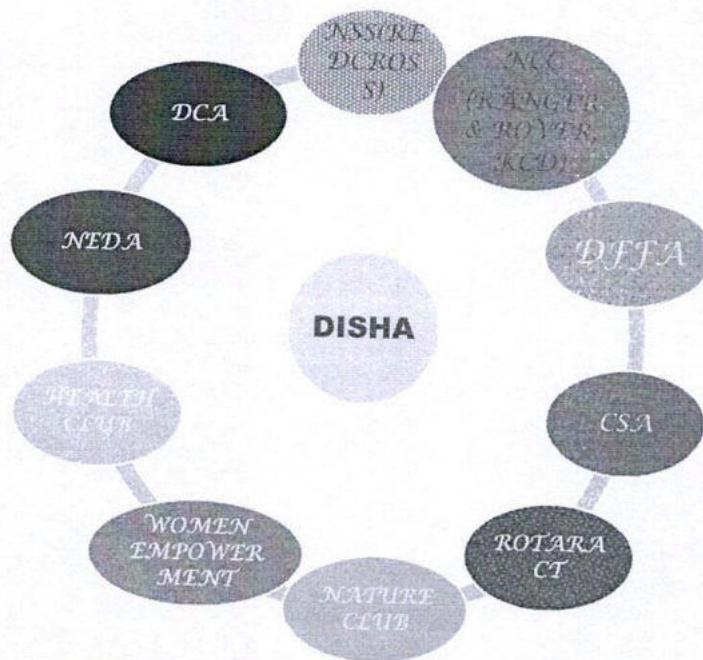

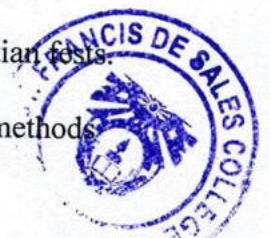
Objectives:
