
Report:




Introduction



- 1 Define the population
- 2 Specify the sampling frame
- 3 Specify sampling units
- 4 Selection of sampling method
- 5 Determine of the sample size
- 6 Specify the sampling plan
- 7 Select the sample

Learning outcome:



1. Participants have learnt about statistical requirements of research

5. Participants have given hands on session on creation of questionnaire with the help of G-form.


