The economic system of any country is largely dependent upon the efficiency of its transport system, without the help of a good transport system, the expansion in national and international trade would never take place.

Broadly, the means of transport both for the purposes of trade and the social activity can be classified into three main divisions, land, water and air. We are, here concerned with transport, for trade, of all the forms of transport, road transport has shown the greatest growth in recent years. Transport by road may be vehicular and non vehicular. Non Vehicular transportation includes both animal and man. Animals are frequently used for carrying goods and passengers in hilly areas.

Water transport is one of the oldest forms of cargo transport. Though it is slow, it is the cheapest form of transport. Water transport includes inland transport and ocean transport, rivers and canals. Ocean or sea transport is very important for the growth of foreign trade of any country especially as it is cheaper than air transport.

The greatest advantage of air transport is that it has reduced the time and distance barrier to a great extent however, air transport is the costliest means of transport because of the high cost of planes, their operation and maintenance.
