Report:

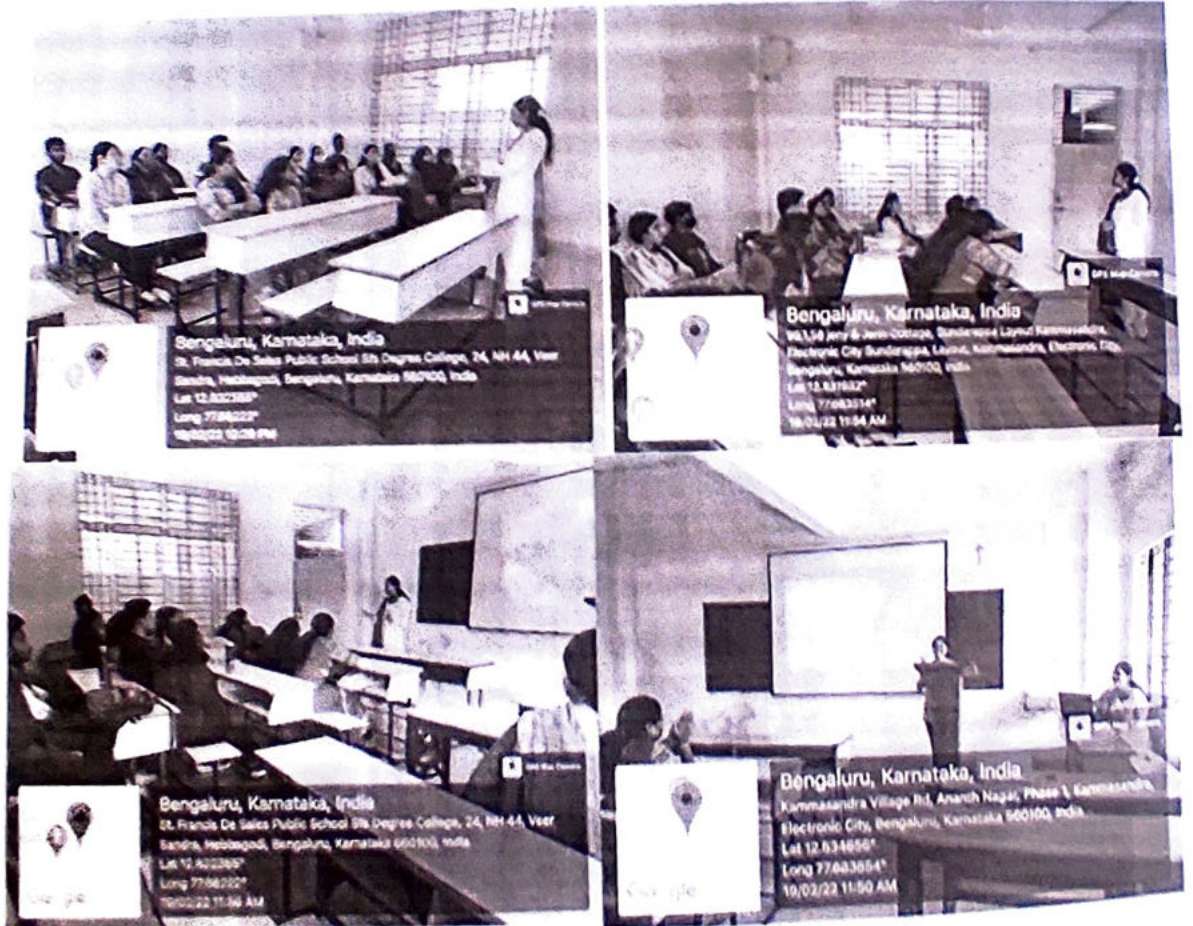
The Department of Psychology, Postgraduate Centre, conducted the second skill development workshop for the students on "Effective Communication Skills" on 19 February 2022 at 11:40 am. The resource person for the workshop was Ms. Nida Syeda, who is a Ph.D. scholar with Christ (Deemed-to-be) University, Bangalore. She has completed her MA in English from Jyoti Nivas College, Bangalore. Her area of research is on different modes of control that influence knowledge production on user generated online platforms. Her areas of interests are digital humanities and cultural studies.

The workshop began with a welcome note by Ms. Preethi, who also introduced the speaker to the gathering. The session was then handed over to the speaker. She began with an interaction with the students on how important they think is communication in their lives, then she moved on to show the snaps of few famous speakers all over the world. Students were asked to identify the names and asked if they have ever listened to them speaking. Most of the students recognised all their speakers and shared their thoughts on the same. She then moved on to speak about the importance of spatiality in communication. She explained with examples as to how people differ in their communication when they are in a personal and professional space. She discussed about the different aspects of communication like kinesics, paralinguistics and chronemics.
